

## Appendix 6 – Coral Spawning Correspondence Register

The Pluto LNG Project has been operational for a total of seven Coral Spawning windows from October 2008 to October 2009. Spawning assessments were completed for all of the predicted spawning windows outlined in Section 4.6.6 of the DSDMP. Dredging activities were suspended where required following consultation with the DEMG. This was required on two occasions within the 2009 reporting period. The following table summarises correspondence between Woodside and the DEC in relation to coral spawning.
